Articles on technology related to sources of energy and fuels written for the layman. Examples of areas that will be covered are:

- Synthetic Gas Production - Gas from coal.
- Fischer Tropsch Process - Conversion of coal to liquid fuel.
- SASOL Process - Adaptation of Fisher Tropsch process.
- Mobil Process - Conversion of natural gas to liquid fuel.
